In recognition of our impact, RADION International was named among the 30 Most Influential Brands in Asia in 2016. CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

As we close another year of faithful service, I am deeply moved by what God has accomplished through RADION — across borders, communities, and lives.

2024 has been a year of strength, growth, and renewed clarity in our mission to be a catalyst for transformation among the most vulnerable. Across Thailand and Singapore, the ministry continues to build on firm foundations — meeting urgent needs while investing in lasting change. From rescuing at-risk children and empowering rural families to providing trauma care and crisis relief, every initiative reflects our conviction that love in action transforms lives.

This year, RADION directly impacted over 12,958 individuals. In Thailand, our StreetKIDS shelters remain a refuge for 54 children, offering safety, healing, and purpose. The HOPE Scholarship Programme supported 18 undergraduates and celebrated seven graduates — each a living testimony of what hope can achieve. The HOPE Center expanded its trauma counselling and community mental health outreach, while VillageCARE brought dignity and comfort to the elderly and terminally ill.

Our crisis relief teams also responded swiftly to droughts and floods in Chiang Mai and Phetchabun — delivering clean water, food, and care to thousands. Behind every number is a story — a life touched, a family restored, and a community strengthened.

In Singapore, the ministry continues to mature in governance, strategy, and accountability, guided by a committed Board and Advisors serving pro bono. Our team strengthened partnerships and volunteer engagement, while our Thai office made major strides in local fundraising and ownership of the work. Together, both offices stand united in purpose and heart.

On behalf of the Board and leadership, I thank our staff, volunteers, donors, and partners — the steady hands and faithful hearts that make this ministry what it is. Your compassion builds bridges where walls once stood, bringing dignity and hope to those we serve.

As we look ahead, we remain committed to walking humbly, serving compassionately, and leading faithfully — trusting that as we radiate light into dark places, God will multiply the impact beyond what we can see or imagine.

This growing sense of ownership and self-reliance marks an important milestone for RADION, as we continue empowering local leadership to carry the mission forward with integrity and purpose.

Looking ahead, our calling remains unchanged: to bring light into dark places and hope into forgotten hearts. We will keep standing with the vulnerable — not out of duty, but out of love — because every life, every child, and every community matters deeply to God and to us.

STREETKIDS PROGRAMME

RESCUE & RECOVERY FOR AT-RISK CHILDREN.

The StreetKIDS Programme is RADION International's flagship child protection and rehabilitation initiative, dedicated to supporting children who are victims of violence, survivors of abuse, and those from high-risk or vulnerable backgrounds.

Through this programme, the Radion International Foundation currently operates two child protection shelters in Thailand, providing a safe and nurturing environment for children aged 5 to 21 years.

These shelters offer comprehensive care, encompassing physical, emotional, and educational support to facilitate holistic rehabilitation and long-term well-being.

As of this year, 54 children are under residential care within the StreetKIDS Programme. Their recovery and growth are guided by a multidisciplinary team of trained professionals, including caregivers, counsellors, and mentors, who deliver daily care, therapy, and life-skills training.

Together, they work to empower each child to overcome trauma, rebuild confidence, and envision a hopeful future.

Beyond rehabilitation, the programme instills values of service, responsibility, and community contribution. Graduates are encouraged to give back to society, becoming positive role models and agents of change within their communities.

HOPE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

The HOPE Scholarship Programme was established to empower underprivileged students who demonstrate both academic excellence and a commitment to community service.

The initiative not only provides financial assistance but also creates meaningful learning and mentorship opportunities through engagement with senior leaders at RADION International.

Since its inception in 2020, the programme has awarded scholarships to 33 university students from various institutions across Thailand. These scholars are selected for their perseverance, potential, and passion to give back to society.

In 2024, seven scholars successfully graduated under the HOPE Scholarship Programme — each carrying forward RADION's values of integrity, service, and leadership into their personal and professional journeys.

VILLAGE CARE

UPHOLDING DIGNITY AND COMPASSION
IN THE FINAL STAGES OF LIFE

VillageCARE is a compassionate initiative dedicated to standing alongside the elderly in the final stages of their lives, upholding their dignity, worth, and humanity.

Each week, our team of dedicated staff and social workers visits elderly individuals in their homes—offering far more than food, essential supplies, or healthcare.

They bring companionship, attentive listening, and heartfelt conversations that provide emotional comfort and a sense of belonging.

Through these regular visits, the team gains a deep understanding of each individual's life story and circumstances, allowing care plans to be tailored to both physical and emotional needs.

At the heart of VillageCARE lies a simple yet profound belief: every person deserves to spend their final years in warmth, dignity, and the comforting assurance that they are valued and remembered.

Currently, the programme provides critical care for 12 elderly individuals. In the coming year, RADION aims to expand this outreach by strengthening partnerships with local churches and community organisations, empowering them to extend compassionate, community-based care for the elderly across the region.

HOPE CENTER

TRAUMA CARE & FAMILY SERVICE CENTER

The HOPE Center stands as the first facility of its kind in the region — uniquely integrating professional trauma rehabilitation with the training of community caregivers. Established to bridge the gap between clinical care and grassroots support, the Center provides a holistic model of healing that treats those in distress while equipping others to care.

Through counselling, therapy, and structured treatment programmes, the HOPE Center delivers comprehensive rehabilitation for children, youth, and families who have experienced physical or psychological trauma. Each intervention is guided by trained professionals who combine clinical expertise with compassion to restore hope and resilience.

The Center operates on a community-supported model: families with greater financial means contribute toward their care, while surplus funds go toward subsidising treatment for those with limited resources. This approach fosters a culture of mutual support, ensuring that no one is denied help due to financial hardship.

Beyond direct care, the HOPE Center serves as a regional training hub for mental health awareness and caregiver development. It conducts workshops and training programmes for NGOs, educational institutions, and private sector organisations, strengthening mental health capacity across communities.

In 2024, the HOPE Center hosted multiple mental health training sessions and advocacy events that were well received by both government and private sector partners. These initiatives reflect a growing recognition of mental health as a shared community responsibility, and reaffirm RADION's commitment to building a trauma-informed, compassionate society.

DELIVERING AID WHERE IT'S NEEDED MOST

RADION's Crisis Relief Programme is dedicated to providing life-saving humanitarian assistance and essential support to families affected by natural disasters, conflicts, and emergencies. Our mission is clear — to ensure that help reaches those in need swiftly, effectively, and with dignity during their most critical moments.

When disaster strikes, RADION mobilises its rapid response teams to deliver emergency aid including food, clean water, shelter, medical supplies, and psychosocial support.

Through partnerships with local authorities, community leaders, and international organisations, we strengthen preparedness and resilience in disaster-prone areas — reducing vulnerability and empowering communities to face future crises with greater confidence.

Over the years, RADION's Crisis Relief Programme has responded to numerous emergencies across the region, including floods, earthquakes, landslides, and public health crises. Each response reflects our core belief: that every life matters, and timely compassion can turn devastation into hope.

KHEK NOI DROUGHT RESPONSE (MARCH–APRIL 2024)

Between March and April 2024, the Khek Noi community in Khao Kho District, Phetchabun Province, experienced a severe drought that left many households without sufficient water for daily use.

In response, RADION activated its water filtration facility to supply clean, safe drinking water free of charge to local residents. This initiative enabled families to have reliable access to water for drinking and cooking throughout the crisis.

During this period, 1,053 households benefited directly from the relief effort.

DELIVERING AID WHERE IT'S NEEDED MOST

CHIANG MAI FLOOD RESPONSE (OCTOBER 2024)

In late 2024, Chiang Mai Province was struck by widespread flooding following weeks of heavy rainfall from August to September.

Rising water levels in the Ping River and its tributaries caused severe inundation across multiple districts — including Muang Chiang Mai, San Sai, Sarapee, and Hang Dong — resulting in extensive damage to homes, farmland, and infrastructure.

More than 20,000 households were affected by the disaster.

Operating within the impacted zones, RADION International swiftly mobilised its Crisis Relief team, delivering life-saving aid to 4,453 individuals across Hang Dong, Sarapee, and Lamphun Province.

Relief efforts included the distribution of clean drinking water, mosquito nets, and essential dry food supplies, ensuring that families received immediate support to stabilise and recover in the aftermath of the floods.

Through these coordinated efforts, RADION reaffirmed its commitment to standing with vulnerable communities — providing timely humanitarian assistance, restoring hope, and strengthening community resilience in times of crisis.





In FY24, Radion Thailand received a total of \$110K in donations and Radion Singapore received a total of \$720K. \$550K was transferred from Radion Singapore to Radion Thailand in support of ministry operations in Thailand.



In 2024, Thai fundraising decreased to 24.03% of operating expenses (OPEX) from 27.24% in FY23.
